Why is it a problem?

This species has the potential to cause huge problems on the River Mease as it out competes the native species. It grows in dense stands and spreads very easily. When it dies back in winter the river banks are left bare and easily erode which releases sediment and phosphorus into the river.

Volunteers are needed!

WatersideCare and The Trent Rivers Trust are working together to control this problem species. We are running days where local people can volunteer to help remove it. Training is provided. Its good exercise, a chance to get outside and it's fun! This is a great opportunity to help our native species flourish.
